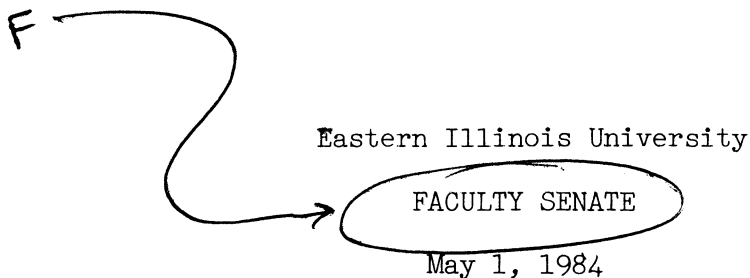

REPORT:

PRESIDENT'S OFFICE  
EASTERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY

Sharon Bartling reported:

The Faculty Advisory Committee to the Illinois Board of Higher Education met at Rend Lake College, April 27, to hear Dr. Bernard Waren, Deputy Director for Government Relations, discuss current education bills being considered by the General Assembly. Unfortunately Dr. Waren was ill, and the discussion was postponed until a June meeting. However, one concern that the legislators have expressed was mentioned: the raising of tuition at public universities in order to fund faculty salary increases.

As you know, I have been reporting to you for four years and my term as Eastern's representative to the FAC is now ending. I have enjoyed the assignment and have learned a great deal about higher education in Illinois. Thank you for your interest and support. I know that you will continue both when my successor takes over in July.

COMMENDATION:

The Faculty Senate commends Dr. Sharon Bartling for her excellent and extensive work in representing Eastern on the Faculty Advisory Committee to the IBHE.

NOMINATIONS:

1. Sutton moved, seconded by Rooke, to approve the attached Student-Faculty Boards list for 1984-85. Motion passed unanimously.
2. Coon moved, seconded by Sullivan, to appoint Jacque Jacobs to the Council of Faculties. Motion passed unanimously.
3. Coon moved, seconded by Jacobs, to appoint Nancy Taitt to the Textbook Rental Service Committee. Motion passed unanimously.

## STUDENT-FACULTY RELATIONS:

1. Sutton moved, seconded by Sullivan, that membership on the Union Advisory Board for faculty members shall be for three years. During their first year the appointees will serve in an observing alternate capacity with voting power only in the absence of regular members; and during the remaining period they (the appointees) will become regular members. Motion passed unanimously.
2. Coon moved, seconded by Nordin, that a faculty member with business/budgetary expertise shall be appointed to the Union Advisory Board in an ex-officio capacity for a three-year term. This is a new Board position. Motion passed, 9 for, 3 abstentions.

## COUNCIL ON FACULTY RESEARCH:

Bud May and Bob Whittenbarger talked with the Senate about the structure of the COFR. There was some question about the various areas on campus being properly represented. After some discussion it was agreed that there is appropriate distribution on the present committee and that the Senate will study the situation next year.

## COMMENDATION:

Chair Goodrick said that if there were a most valuable player award in the Senate, John LeDuc would be the recipient. The Senate strongly agreed!

Sullivan moved, seconded by Nordin, to go into executive session. Motion passed unanimously. Coon moved, seconded by Nordin, to come out of executive session. Motion passed unanimously.
