CHARLESTON, IL--Special programs at Eastern Illinois University will bring more than 1,900 visitors to Charleston this week (July 1-7).

The largest event is a canvasser's conference, July 5-8, with 1,200 participants.

Approximately 300 Fall 1990 freshmen and transfer students will be on the campus, July 1-6, to pre-enroll for classes.

Another large event is the National Cheerleading Association's Pom Pon Camp, July 6-9, with 250 participants.
