EXECUTIVE SESSION:

Rooke moved, seconded by Floyd, to go into executive session. Motion passed unanimously. Searle moved, seconded by Jacobs, to come out of executive session. Motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Faculty Dining Room: Heumann noted that his meeting with Glenn Williams was a positive one. The Vice President for Student Affairs will support a small faculty dining area.
2. CAA Reorganization: Joe Butler addressed the Senate concerning the petition proposing reorganization of the Council on Academic Affairs. The Student Council President opposes the petition because he believes the yearly election of student members on CAA would be expensive and time consuming. He further noted that the reduction of student membership on CAA would cause a lack of faith among students and tension between faculty and students. The Senate refused to respond either for or against the petition.

The meeting adjourned at 4:20. The next meeting of the Faculty Senate will be on call.
