EBERLY HONORED BY COUNSELING ASSOCIATION

CHARLESTON, IL.--Charles G. Eberly of Charleston, assistant professor of educational psychology and guidance at Eastern Illinois University, is the recipient of the Association for Measurement and Evaluation in Counseling and Development (AMECD) Presidential Service Award.

Eberly received the award in recognition of his dedicated service to the Association as president from 1989-1990.

AMECD, a division of the American Association for Counseling and Development, was founded in 1965 to serve the counseling profession's needs for information and education in measurements, assessment and testing.

The Association's 1,700 members are involved in the construction, norming, use and interpretation of standardized testing and assessment instruments in school, community and mental health settings.

As president-elect, Eberly participated in the revision of the Association's guidelines for the responsible use of tests by professional counselors, the Responsibilities of Users of Standardized Tests (RUST) document.

Prior to his election as president, Eberly served four years as the AMECD treasurer and four years as editor of the house newsletter, AMECD Newsnotes.

At EIU, Eberly teaches courses in the practical uses of measurement and testing for counselors-in-training, and courses in college student personnel administration in the Department of Educational Psychology and Guidance in the College of Education.
