CHARLESTON, IL--Official 1986 Fall Semester on-campus enrollment at Eastern Illinois University increased to 9,982, up 56 students over the Fall of 1985.

The increase was announced Wednesday by President Stan Rives. "We are pleased," said Rives, "at the fundamental stability of our enrollment. Eastern offers quality education at a reasonable cost and we're delighted that the institution remains attractive to Illinois students."

Official enrollments for all Illinois universities are established by the number of students enrolled in classes as of the tenth class day, which was September 9 for EIU.

On-campus enrollment by class includes 2,862 freshmen, 1,960 sophomores, 2,153 juniors, 2,117 seniors, and 895 graduate students. There are 47 more freshmen and 47 more graduate students enrolled over comparable figures for Fall 1985.

There are 9,066 full-time and 916 part-time students at Eastern. Women outnumber men 5,278 to 4,704. Official 1985 Fall Semester EIU on-campus enrollment was 9,926.

Enrollment in off-campus courses is still in progress. Total on- and off-campus enrollment is expected to exceed the 10,491 of last year.

President Rives praised the work of Eastern's Vice President for Student Affairs and Admissions Office which, he said, "maintained stable enrollment despite a cut-off of freshman admission on March 15."
