EXECUTIVE SESSION:

Perkins moved, seconded by Norberg, to go into executive session. Motion passed unanimously. Coon moved, seconded by Sullivan, to come out of executive session. Motion passed unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Sullivan moved, seconded by Stevens, that the minutes of October 30 be approved. Motion passed unanimously.
2. Coon moved, seconded by Sullivan, that the minutes of November 6 be approved as amended. Motion passed unanimously.

CORRECTION:

Page 20, Item 2, line 7: "would" should be "could."

3. North Central Association Visit: Ken Lindler, chair of the North Central Association Team, explained the function and procedure of the North Central Association Team's visit. He then asked the Senate to explain its role at Eastern. Senate members spoke at length concerning the various responsibilities of the Faculty Senate: conducting elections for major University committees, appointing some members of University Boards, receiving input from concerned faculty members, appointing a representative to the BOG Council of Faculties, conducting executive committee meetings with President Rives, etc.

1. Band Performance at Reagan-Bush Political Rally: The Senate postponed action until the next meeting.
