March 19, 1985

Heumann moved, seconded by Norberg, that the minutes of March 12 be approved as amended. Motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Title Change for the Director of University Relations: Norberg presented, seconded by Oseguera, the following motion:

No evidence has been presented to this Faculty Senate that justifies a change in the title of the Director of University Relations. Therefore, the Faculty Senate recommends no change at this time.

Motion passed.

2. Evaluation of Deans: Senate members agreed that the executive committee of the Faculty Senate should speak to President Rives concerning this issue.
3. Reorganization of Committees: Stevens moved, seconded by Oseguera, that the Faculty Senate review the issue of reorganization of the standing committees of the faculty.
4. Student/Faculty Relations: Morice reported that the Student Senate wants to hold another Open Forum meeting with the Faculty Senate. Areas of concern for the Student Senate are:
 - a). student advisement
 - b). the senior seminar
 - c). the writing competency exam
 - d). a code of ethics for faculty

An issue of concern for the Faculty Senate at any future Open Forum meeting with the Student Senate would be that fraternities and sororities encourage academic achievement among their members.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Access to Library Periodicals: Smith moved, seconded by Oseguera, that the chairperson of the Faculty Senate draft a letter to President Rives supporting controlled access of periodicals.
