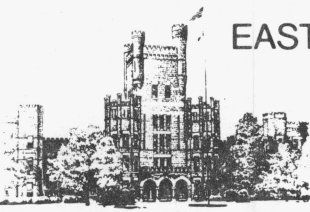

KING TO SPEAK AT EASTERN

CHARLESTON, IL.--Patricia King, an expert in family issues related to ethical and legal concerns, will speak at Eastern Illinois University at 7:30 p.m., Tuesday, July 17, in the Booth Library Lecture Room.

A professor of law at the Georgetown University Law Center in Washington, D.C., King will discuss "Bioethics, Family and the Law." The public is invited to this free lecture.

She will also lead a workshop on family, reproductive technologies and public policy July 16-19. For registration information, call Eastern's Summer School Office at 581-2023.

King has published two books and a number of journal articles on family issues concerning abortion, adoption, rights of the fetus, reproductive technologies, and the legal and ethical issues involved in reproduction.

A graduate of Harvard Law School, she has held a faculty position at Georgetown University since 1974.

Following her lecture, the Office of Summer School and the Women's Studies Council will sponsor a reception in her honor outside the Booth Library Lecture Room.
