KAUFMAN TO ATTEND C-SPAN SEMINAR

CHARLESTON, IL--Susan Kaufman of Terre Haute, assistant professor of journalism at Eastern Illinois University, has been selected to attend Cable-Satellite Public Affairs Network's Summer 1990 Seminar for Professors August 6-7 in Washington, D.C.

Kaufman was one of 35 college and university instructors selected through a competitive application. All 2,100 college-level members of "C-SPAN in the Classroom," the cable television network's free national membership organization for educators, were invited to apply.

The "C-Span in the Classroom" agenda includes professional round table discussions and workshops, participation in a live, nationally televised viewer call-in program and a reception at the National Press Club.

Seminar participants represent two- and four-year institutions from across the country. Represented fields of study include political science, journalism, communication and law.
