CHARLESTON, IL.--The Arcadia Ensemble, a trio-sonata group based in Charleston, will present a concert of baroque music on period instruments at Eastern Illinois University on Tuesday, Nov. 4 in Dvorak Concert Hall at 7:30 p.m.

Members of the Ensemble are Elaine Fine, flute; Kathreen Ryan, violin; Gretchen Tracy, cello; and Gary Zwicky, harpsichord.

The program will include solo and chamber works by Bach, a concerto by Handel, and a trio-sonata by Johann Friederich Fasch.

Fine taught and studied in Austria after graduating from the Julliard School of Music. She had played with the Hong Kong Philharmonic and the Boston Harmonic.

Ryan had played with the Champaign, Decatur and Springfield symphonies and is currently a member of the Peoria Symphony and concertmistress of the Bradley Chamber Orchestra.

Tracy studied cello with Roger Drinkall at Queens College in North Carolina. She completed a bachelor of music degree at East Carolina University and holds a master's degree from Eastern.

Zwicky has taught orchestra at Eastern since 1966 and harpsichord since 1970. The Ensemble recently played a concert in Chicago and has performed regularly in east-central Illinois.
