CHARLESTON, IL--Daniel Goble, Eastern Illinois University professor of saxophone, will present a recital on Thursday, Nov. 13 at 7:30 p.m. in Dvorak Concert Hall. Assisting will be pianist Eduard Laurel, Austin, Texas, and Eastern faculty members Timothy Lane, flute and Donald Tracy, cello.

Before coming to Eastern this year, Goble was a professional saxophonist and woodwind specialist in Boulder, Colo. He has appeared throughout the U.S. as a recitalist and clinician. He has performed with Mel Torme, Steve Lawrence, Rich Little, Bob Hope and Nelson Riddle.

The program will include works by Bach, Ibert, and the Pulitzer Prize winning composer Charles Wourinen. There is no admission charge.
