Minutes for the April 22 meeting were approved with the following corrections,  
 motion by Heyduck, seconded by Sutton:

1. The meeting was on April 22.
2. Regarding department name change to Health Studies: a motion to support the name change was made by Smith, seconded by Sullivan. The motion carried unanimously.
3. VPAA Schick's information on status of academic programs: the 120 percent should have been 141 percent.
4. Nomination Committee appointed Smith and Ozier to the committee to review the by-laws of academic councils.

COMMUNICATIONS:

1. President Rives memo regarding the decision to make the position for Adult and Continuing Education a Dean position.
2. Memo requesting two representatives to serve on the Search Committee. Ozier appointed Sutton and John North to serve on the Committee.
3. Memo from Walter Lowell expressing appreciation for the Faculty Senate's retirement plaque.
4. Memo from Department of Speech Pathology and Audiology in regard to their proposal to change the department name to Communication Disorders and Sciences.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Elections Committee in regard to the election of COTE members: a protest was made on the basis that some members who should have been allowed to vote for COTE membership were not allowed to vote. The misunderstanding developed from a change made by COTE. COTE failed to officially notify the Faculty Senate about the change. In view of the fact that the Faculty Senate does have a protest system available at the time of the elections, no protest was made, and in view of the fact that only about one-half of the eligible voters did vote for the membership of COTE, the following motion was made. A motion was made by Perkins, seconded by Coon, to let the election stand until the next regularly scheduled election. The motion passed unanimously.

OLD BUSINESS: (cont.)

2. Membership on Student Faculty Boards for 1986-87. (see attached)
3. Ad Hoc Committee report on optional spring semester tuition and fees payment plan. The committee supports the spring semester only two installment pay plan which includes a \$20 non-refundable service fee.
