The meeting was called to order by Chairperson North at 2:00 p.m. in the Martinsville Room of the Martin Luther King Student Union.

- I. Minutes of the December 8 meeting were approved as presented.
- II. COMMUNICATIONS:
 - A. Received minutes from the Committee on Academic Computing's Dec. 11 meeting.
 - B. Received a letter from Deb Camren notifying the Faculty Senate of student appointments (Dan Riordan and Pete Mills) to the Traffic and Safety Board.
 - C. Received copies of "The Role of the IBHE in this Period of Budgetary Reductions" from Robert Whittenbarger, EIU's representative to the IBHE Faculty Advisory Committee
 - D. Received a letter from Philip Rock, President of the Illinois State Senate, explaining his vote to not override the governor's veto and addressing the funding of public education, but not higher education, in Illinois.
 - E. Received a letter from Robert Kindrick noting that additional travel funds and summer faculty research grants might yet be provided and expressing his continuing commitment to faculty research
 - F. Received a copy of a letter to Tony Schaeffer from Erin Render, secretary of the Library Board. Paul Rao suggests that the Committee on Academic Computing adopt as their organizational model something similar to the Library Board
 - G. Received from Lewis Coon a letter requesting that the Faculty Senate assist in the distribution of petitions to decertify the union (AFT-BOG Council 3500, AKA UPI-BOG Council 4100). Any vote to decertify would require that 30% of all members in the collective bargaining unit sign the petitions and that the petitions be returned to the Illinois Educational Labor Relations Board by Feb. 15. This will be an agenda item for discussion at the next Faculty Senate meeting.

- IV. NEW BUSINESS:
 - A. Robert Kindrick has named John North as a reactor to BOG meetings. Jack Schuster will be the speaker at the Jan. 20-21 meeting. The month's topic is faculty.
 - B. President Rives will attend the next Faculty Senate meeting.
