The Green River State Wildlife Area is in the Green River Lowland Section of the Grand Prairie Natural Division of Illinois. The Wildlife Area is about 14 mile directly south of Dixon, Illinois. Harmon 7.5 minute quadrangle. Elevation about 680 feet. Growing in forest dominated by *Acer saccharinum* with *Prunus serotina* and *Morus* sp.
