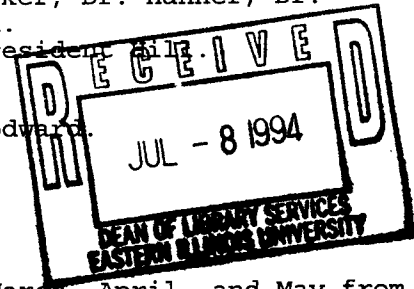

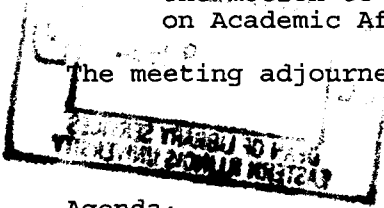
The June 30, 1994 meeting of the Council on Academic Affairs was held in the BOG Room of Booth Library.
