EIU CLASSES OFFERED AT DACC

CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University's School of Adult and Continuing Education is offering 21 Fall courses and workshops at Danville Area Community College.

EIU's graduate offerings for educators include "Introduction to Organization and Administration," "Introduction to Research in Education," and "Diagnosis of Reading Problems." The course, "Operations Management and Administrative Policy," is offered to individuals pursuing the Master of Business Administration degree.

Courses for either graduate or undergraduate credit include "Teaching About Illinois," "Safety Management," "Critical Thinking Skills," "Training Systems Administration," "Sociotechnical Design," and "Principles of Career Development."

A special one-credit workshop, "Physiology of Addiction," is designed for individuals in health care, education, and human services professions and deals with the physical mechanisms that cause drug addiction. It also includes the implications for treatment and the common theories of why drug abuse occurs.

Undergraduate offerings include "Philosophy and History of Education," "Science in the Elementary School," "Technology and Society," "History of Christianity," "The Known Universe," "Structure of English" and "Portfolio Development."

A special two-credit undergraduate course, "Introduction to Pen and Ink Drawing," will meet Sept. 7-8, 14-15, and 21-22. It provides an in-depth introduction to two-dimensional drawing utilizing pen and ink and covers figure drawing, traditional still-life and environmental settings, with an emphasis on skills development.

"Stress Management for Young Professionals," meets Sept. 7-8 and presents a holistic concept of mind/body wellness and examines stress management techniques, including the use of biofeedback, nutrition, relaxation, Rational Emotive Thinking, and time management strategies.

A special information session will be held in DACC's Vermilion Room at 6:30 p.m. on Aug. 7, for those needing more information regarding EIU's off-campus degree programs and courses, and information on enrolling.

EIU's fall semester begins Aug. 22. Tuition per semester hour is \$65.50 for freshmen/sophomores, \$66.50 for juniors/seniors, and \$70 for graduate students.
