Minutes of April 11, 1989**

The meeting was called to order by Gary Foster at 2:05 p.m. in Martinsville Room of the Martin Luther King Student Union.

I. Minutes of the April 4th meeting were unanimously approved.

II. **Communications:**

A. Received a copy of the President's Report to the BOG for April 13.

B. Received notification from Don Paige, of a Faculty Leadership meeting with state representatives in Springfield, April 27. Due to conflicts in his schedule Chair Foster will not be able to attend this meeting. Dr. Marlow said that he would represent the Faculty Senate at the meeting.

C. Received the BOG Agenda for April 13.

III. **Old Business:**

A. Dr. Kruse noted that the Distinguished Faculty nominations are due this Friday and will be reviewed with a decision made by April 20.

B. Chair Foster reported on the Academic Program Review meeting with Chancellor Pringle. He (Foster) noted that there were 12 BOG recommendations that were at variance with the recommendations EIU had made.

IV. **New Business:**

A. Dr. Saltmarsh reported on the Faculty Council Advisory meetings. The March meeting was primarily an informational meeting for the committee. SHEEO (State Higher Education Executive Officers) grant project proposal was presented at the meeting. The grants purpose is to "make the world a better place for minority transfers from community colleges to four year colleges"; to increase the likelihood that these students will earn an associate degree at the community colleges and thereby transfer easily to a four year institution and go on to complete their baccalaureate degrees. The SHEEO project is recommending implementation of strategies at the community college and four year institution level to increase the potential for these students to be successful in completing degrees and also in transferring to other institutions. A representative from the community college interest from throughout the state of Illinois presented information regarding articulation. The community college people have produced a document which suggests things that four year institutions should be doing to help in articulation of students. Also, the Director of the Illinois Academy for Math & Science presented a video tape of the campus and programs, providing information as to what is going on at the academy.

B. The Faculty Senate Election results are published on the attached page. 308 ballots were cast in the election. Motion was made to ratify the election results as presented. (Schaeffer/Carpenter) Motion carried unanimously.

C. The Faculty Senate Appointments for the Faculty/Student Boards were presented. The appointments are also listed on the attached page. Motion was made to approve the appointments as presented. (North/Schaeffer) Motion carried unanimously.

D. Chair Foster voiced appreciation on behalf of the Faculty Senate to the Elections Committee made up of: Tony Schaeffer, Nancy McMillan, and Glenn Hild. Also, appreciation was expressed to the Faculty Senate Nomination Committee made up of: Evelyn Goodrick, David Carpenter, and John North.

Meeting was adjourned at 2:45 p.m. The next Senate meeting will be April 18, 2:00 in the Martinsville Room.
