EIU CLASSES OFFERED AT MILLIKIN

CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University's School of Adult and Continuing Education has announced its Fall programs for Decatur.

EIU is offering five semester courses at Millikin University for teachers interested in pursuing a master's degree with Eastern, or wishing to further their professional development. Course offerings include "School Community Relations," "Supervision of Instruction," "Philosophy of Education: Interpretive," and "Teaching and Supervision of Social Studies in the Elementary Schools."

Of special interest to teachers in the Decatur and Macon County area is a one-credit weekend workshop designed for the general classroom teacher entitled "Individual and Group Management of Children with Emotional Disturbances." This workshop, designed to help teachers deal with children who display emotional/behavioral problems, will meet on Oct. 26-27.

For community college graduates and others who wish to pursue an undergraduate degree, EIU offers eight classes at Richland Community College, including "Drugs and Society," "The Reagan Revolution," "Government and Business," "Gorbachev and Glasnost," "Child Psychology," "Machine Design," and Supervision."

EIU is also offering a one-credit workshop at RRC, "Eating Disorders Among Adolescents and Young Adults." This workshop is designed for individuals, parents and teachers who deal with individuals 13 to 45, who are struggling with issues associated with eating disturbances. Among the disorders discussed will be Anorexia Nervosa, Bulimia and Obesity. The workshop will meet Oct. 26-27 and is available for either graduate or undergraduate credit.

EIU's fall semester begins Aug. 22. Tuition per semester hour is \$65.50 for freshmen/sophomores, \$66.50 for juniors/seniors, and \$70 for graduate students.

A special information session will be conducted at Richland Community College in room S134 at 6:30 p.m., July 31, for those needing more information regarding EIU's off-campus degree programs and courses and information on enrolling.
