CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University's School of Adult and Continuing Education has announced its Fall schedule for Parkland College, with twenty-two courses and workshops offered.

Three special workshops for individuals interested in educational administration will deal with critical issues and controversies in educational administration, and are offered for either graduate or undergraduate credit.
