ARNOLD NAMED CHAIR

CHARLESTON, IL.--Aline Arnold of Charleston, Associate Professor of Management at Eastern Illinois University since 1988, has been named Chair of the Department of Management and Marketing.

Arnold, former Chair and Arlie Mays Professor of the Division of Business at Wayland Baptist University in Plainview, Texas, replaces Dalton Brannon who served as Department Chair since 1989 and has accepted a position at Augusta College in Georgia.

She will oversee 21 faculty and 300 students majoring in management/marketing.

Listed in Who's Who in American Women, Arnold received an associate's degree from Eastfield College in Dallas, Texas, and bachelor's, master's and doctoral degrees from the University of North Texas, where she taught management related course work from 1978 to 1985.

At UNT, she also served as Director of the Center for Public Health Studies and Executive Assistant to the Chancellor. Prior to joining the UNT faculty, she taught economics at Dallas Baptist College.

A former hospital administrator, she has special research interest in strategic planning for health facilities, the impact of competition in the health industry, and alternative health delivery systems.

She and her husband, Gene, a retired hospital administrator and part-time management consultant, have a daughter, Teresa Anderson of Ennis, Texas.
