U.S. AMBASSADOR TO U.N. VISITING EIU

CHARLESTON, IL.--The Honorable M. James Wilkinson, U.S. Ambassador to the United Nations and Deputy U.S. Representative in the Security Council, will visit Eastern Illinois University to update the University community about the latest world crisis.

The public is invited to hear Ambassador Wilkinson discuss "Facing the World Crisis" at 7:30 p.m., Monday, Oct. 29, in Eastern's Buzzard Auditorium. There will be time for a question and answer session.

Together with Ambassador Thomas Pickering, Ambassador Wilkinson represents the United States in the various United Nations councils and agencies in New York.
