Growing with *Quercus palustris*, *Platanthera flava* var. *herbiola*, *Veronica scutellata*,
Nyssa sylvatica, *Carex subrecta*, *Thelypteris palustris*, *Lycopus americanus*,
Sisyrinchium atlanticum, *Agrimonia parviflora*, *Glyceria striata*, *Eleocharis wolfii*,
Eleocharis sp., etc. Blue flowered perennial herb, lateral and lower petals all bearded.
