In the Grand Prairie Section of the Grand Prairie Natural Division. Coordinate Datum: WGS84/NAD83. Disturbed dolomite prairie on dry area with slight slope dominated by Bromus inermis with Allium cernuum, Claytonia virginica, Daucus carota, Eleocharis compressa, Lepidium campestre, Minuartia patula, Muhlenbergia cuspidata, Oxalis violacea, Poa pratensis, Potentilla arguta, Rosa carolina, Sorghastrum nutans, etc. Perennial herb with white flowers that are turning pink at this time.
