WOMEN'S TENNIS HOSTS BRADLEY (3:30 p.m.)

WOMEN'S SOFTBALL: Eastern Illinois University's Lady Panther softball team (0-5, 3-1) opened Gateway Conference action by winning three of their four contests played this past weekend. Against Bradley on Friday, the pre-season pick to win conference honors, Eastern gained a split, winning 1-0, then losing 1-0 on a no-hitter tossed by Kim Rosenbalm. Against Western Illinois on Saturday, Eastern swept the doubleheader which saw Lady Panther pitcher Zam Mogill, sophomore (Streator, IL) notch her eighth victory against four losses. Mogill was the loser of the 1-0 Bradley victory, although that run was unearned. She also won the opening contest against Bradley 1-0, and the 2-0 triumph over WIU on Saturday. Angel Lendvay, sophomore, (Mundelein, IL) slammed a bases-loaded triple in the opening game against the Westerwinds and then scored on a wild pitch which accounted for the 4-0 whitewash over WIU.

ZAM MOGILL, SOPHOMORE (STREATOR, IL) lowered her ERA record to 0.33 over the past weekend, winning two games and losing the third.

ANGEL LENDVAY, SOPHOMORE (MUNDELEIN, IL) slammed a bases-loaded triple in the opening game against Western for three RBI, and then scored on a wild pitch.

BRENDA JACKSON, SOPHOMORE (LYONS, IL/MORTON WEST) accounted for two of the four hits against Western Illinois University in last Saturday's 2-0 Panther victory.

SARA KARCHER, SOPHOMORE (WAYNE CITY, IL) picked up her second victory of the season in Eastern's 4-0 victory over Western Illinois.

MEN'S TENNIS: The Eastern Illinois University men's tennis team lost the home opener Wednesday against Bradley by a 7-2 score.

Coming off a successful 5-2 spring trip, coach John Bennett was concerned that the team did not play up to par. "They played well on spring trip. Against Bradley, they didn't do the things they did on break."

The highlight of the match was Don Carstens (Frankfort) who won in both singles and double action. At the No. 5 position, Carstens defeated Jim Fraggos in three sets 6-4, 3-6, 6-2. Carstens and junior Mark Matijasevich (West Chicago-West Chicago High) teamed up to form the No. 3 doubles duo and defeated Bradley's Steve Kukta and Steve Baab 6-4, 6-4.

In singles action, John Suter (Springfield) the No. 1 player, was defeated in three sets by Keith Hargis 4-6, 6-4, 6-4. The No. 2 player, freshman Jon Anderson (Homewood-Homewood/Flossmoor) was defeated by Juan Franco 6-4, 6-4.

At the No. 3 position, Scott Simon (Mascoutah-Belleville AC) lost to Kukta 3-6, 6-4, 6-2. Matijasevich, Eastern's No. 4 player, lost to Gene Dorsch in straight sets 6-3, 6-3. Senior David Brown (Jacksonville-Jacksonville High) was also defeated in straight sets by Baab 7-5, 6-4.

In doubles action, the No. 1 team of Suter and Anderson was defeated by Franco and Hargis 4-6, 7-6, 6-3. The duo of Simon and Brown, playing at the No. 2 position, was beaten by Dorsch and Fraggos 6-4, 6-4.

MEN'S TRACK: The Eastern Illinois men's track team had many strong performances in this weekend's Illinois State Invitational. The meet was all individual events with no team scoring.

LARRY THOENNISSEN - The senior had an outstanding weekend placing in three events. Thoennissen won the hammer throw with a throw of 171-8. And he placed second in the shot put with a put of 55-9 and one half. He also took a fifth in the discuss with a throw of 158-6.

JIM LAIL - Lail captured first place in the shot put, with a put of 56-1. Lail also placed fourth in the hammer with a throw of 157-19.

DAN MATAS - Matas had a strong showing bettering his personal record in the discuss throw by 10 feet, with a hurl of 163 feet.

JIM MATON - The sophomore took a third in the 1500 meter with a time of 3:56.4. Maton also ran on the second place 4 x 400 meter relay team that has a time of 3:21.
