ALUMNI BOARD MEETING

EIU Foundation President James L. Hanks and Eastern President Stan Rives will brief friends of the University on the status of the Foundation and the campus community.

During the meeting, the Foundation Board will be updated on Eastern's highly successful Second Century Campaign which raised in excess of \$12 million toward a \$20 million goal. The campaign will continue through Dec. 31, 1995.

In addition, the Foundation Board will discuss nine new scholarships to benefit Eastern students.

The EIU Foundation is comprised of 100 members of which Governor Jim Edgar is one.

It is governed by a nine-member board responsible for managing assets totalling \$8 million.
