CHARLESTON, ILL (April 29, 1986) -- The Eastern Illinois women's softball team may be winding down for rookie head coach Janet Marquis, but the future is even brighter for the Lady Panthers.

EIU--24-11-1 overall and 10-4 in the Gateway Conference--will host league-foes Wichita State (May 2) and Southwest Missouri (May 3) before preparing for the Gateway Conference tournament at Peoria, IL May 8-10.

The Lady Panthers are second in the league while chasing Illinois
State (12-4) and attempting to hold off third-place Indiana State (11-6).

A couple of the reasons why the present—and future—is bright for Eastern are record—setting sophomores ANGEL LENDVAY (Mundelein) and ZAM MOGILL (Streator). Lendvay—a strong—armed right fielder—is hitting .294 with a team—leading 34 hits and and 13 RBIs. The all—league selection a year ago as a freshman, Lendvay has nine triples this season and 14 on her career—both school records. Kelly Waldrup held the old school career record with 10 over three seasons.

Lendvay garnered 10 hits in 25 at bats last week for a .400 batting average. Out of her 10 hits, five were extra bases--four triples and a double. She also collected four RBIs and scored the winning run in a crucial league win over Southern Illinois.

Mogill—a former national prep record—holder—is regarded as one of the premier hurlers in the Midwest. She owns an impressive 19-7 record with 13 shutouts. The powerfully—built right—hander has a 0.43 ERA and 201 strikeouts. Her 197.1 innings pitched in 1986 is a season mark.

Over the span of just under two seasons, the math education major has put together some impressive numbers: She has notched a 33-17-2 (.667) record while stiking out 307 batters—an EIU career record. Equally impressive, Mogill has 27 earned runs in 382.2 innings for an ERA of 0.49. Her 23 career shutouts are two short of the school-record as are her 13 blankings this season.

SARA KARCHER (Wayne City) -- another sophomore standout -- has been in the thick of things all season for EIU. The veratile athlete has an impressive .248 batting average while also placing second on the team in RBIs with 10. When not toiling at shortstop for the Lady Panthers, she acts as EIU's second pitcher. Karcher has a 5-4 record with four shutouts.
