CHARLESTON, IL. --Eastern Illinois University baseball player TIM TORRICELLI, a catcher from Springfield, has signed a free agent contract with the Milwaukee Brewers, head coach Tom McDevitt announced.

TORRICELLI was signed by Brewers scout Ken Bracey, and has been assigned to Beloit (W) in the Class A Midwest League.

"I never recommend a player who doesn't have the potential to play professional baseball," said McDevitt, "and Tim does have potential. He's fighting size but he has enough tools to catch."

TORRICELLI led the Panthers in most offensive categories last year including batting (.365) and RBIs (49).

On the EIU career list, he's No. 2 in homers (20) and RBIs (117) and holds the record for most career walks with 95. He was over .300 batting in three of four years with a single season high of .380 as a freshman.

TORRICELLI is the 20th player to sign a professional contract during McDevitt's tenure as head coach, and the 39th signee since World War II.
