ABOUT THE ILLINI: Illinois is 2-0 opening with a Thanksqiving holiday championship in the BYU-Hawaii Classic defeating New Mexico State, 67-65, and Duke, 69-62 . . . KEN NORMAN had 22 points, 13 rebounds vs. the Blue Devils, who were NCAA runner-up last year . . . NORMAN leads the team with a 24 point average . . . DOUG ALTENBERGER is scoring 11.5 . . . top player off the bench is quard GLYNN BLACKWELL who had 17 vs. Duke . . . the Illini are rated No. 9 in the country.

THE PANTHERS: EIU won its opener, 85-54, over Illinois Tech and again displayed balanced scoring as the Panthers had four in double figures . . . NORM EVANS (JOLIET-CENTRAL) led with 17 points while DAVE VANCE (ROSELLE-LAKE PARK) had 14 points/10 rebounds . . .the Panthers finished up shooting slightly over 48% after hitting only 38.5% in the first half . . .EIU was 0-5 from three point range. . .as opposed to last year's starting lineup which featured three seniors, this year's group does not have a senior on the squad and starts three sophomores however there is some experience at EVANS is a two year letterman, TAYLOR, WEST and VANCE each lettered as frosh last season.
