U.S. SENATOR FROM HAWAII TO SPEAK AT EIU

CHARLESTON, IL--United States Senator Daniel Akaka, (D - Hawaii), will visit Eastern Illinois University Friday, April 26.

The public is invited to hear Senator Akaka speak on the "Gulf War and Its Aftermath: An American Perspective" at 4 p.m. in Eastern's Lumpkin Hall, Room 122. There will be a question and answer period following the lecture.

Senator Akaka is a member of several Senate Committees including Energy and Natural Resources, Governmental Operations and Veteran Affairs.

Prior to being elected Senator in 1990, he was a member of the U.S. House of Representatives for 14 years and a former Special Assistant to the Governor of Hawaii. Senator Akaka also has more than 15 years of experience in education, both as a teacher and principal.
