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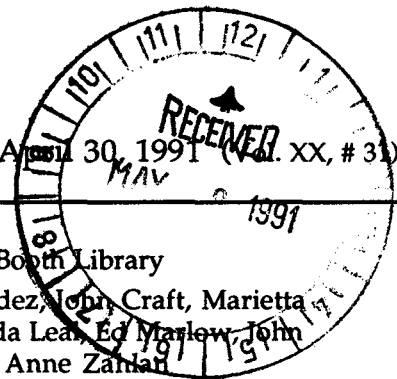
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# Faculty Senate

## II. OLD BUSINESS

- A. **Study on Graduate Education and Research.** Dean Williams and Dr. Nilsen discussed the SGE report with the Senate, and responded to questions about workshop credit, course numberings, the nature of external as opposed to internal research, and monetary concerns including application of indirect cost funds. They expressed willingness to return to the Senate after it has discussed the remaining recommendations.
- B. Concerns about the reassignment of some of Dr. Thornburgh's duties to the Development Office were raised.

## III. NEW BUSINESS

### A. Faculty Senate Elections.

**Chair:** David Carpenter was nominated, and, no other nominations forthcoming, was elected by acclamation.

**Vice-Chair:** Gary Wallace and John Miller were nominated. Miller declined the nomination, and Wallace was elected by acclamation.

**Secretary:** Marietta Deming, Bob Jorstad, and Anne Zahlan were nominated. Deming declined the nomination, and Zahlan was elected by secret ballot.

**B. Student/Faculty Relations.** Chair Carpenter distributed a document explaining "public comments made by individual senators regarding the recent Student-Senate referendum..." The Senate discussed the document and the necessity for healthy student-faculty relations. Discussion may continue next week.
