The scholarship, given to an outstanding student majoring in special education, was established in 1989 in memory of Leslie Dean McSwain, son of J. Earl and Margaret D. McSwain of Charleston. He was a special student at Charleston Junior High at the time of his death.

Epley is also the recipient of the Emma Reinhardt Award. Established in 1962 by members of Kappa Delta Pi in recognition of the late Emma Reinhardt, the award is made annually to the highest ranking junior who has earned a minimum of thirty semester hours at Eastern and who is pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Education degree.
