EIU CLASSES ANNOUNCED IN RANTOUL AREA FOR SUMMER TERM CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University is offering classes this summer in the Rantoul area at Chanute Air Force Base to support graduate and undergraduate degree programs offered there.
