CONLEY NAMED REGISTRAR

CHARLESTON, IL.--John H. Conley of Charleston has been named registrar at Eastern Illinois University, effective Sept. 1.

Conley will replace James E. Martin, who is retiring in August after 23 years of service to the University.

A Flora native, Conley has served as Eastern's assistant registrar since 1972. As registrar, much of his time will be spent conferring with students regarding grade point averages, transfer credit, probation, correspondence courses and proficiency exams.

He will supervise 14 employees and be responsible for interpreting policies and determining athletic eligibility for student athletes and monitoring their progress in accordance with National Collegiate Athletic Association regulations.

"I am looking forward to the challenges of this new position and hope to continue to move toward computerization of all student academic records," Conley said.

Eastern's Dean of Student Academic Services Samuel Taber said, "Mr. Conley's familiarity with Eastern's academic record-keeping system will be an asset. He has proven himself as an effective administrator and I have the utmost confidence in his abilities."

Conley received his bachelor's and master's degrees from Eastern. He served as a public school teacher, coach and principal for several years prior to his employment at Eastern.

He is a member of the American and Illinois Associations of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers and Eastern's Panther Club and Centennial Committee.
