She was honored at Eastern's recent spring commencement ceremony where President Stan Rives presented her with a Lord Medallion.

The Lord Scholarship is awarded annually at commencement to six junior or senior students, one from each undergraduate college within the University who have been nominated by a department chairperson.

Each recipient received a \$2,500 scholarship in addition to a gold medal and certificate.

Yegge, a 1988 graduate of Marion Central Catholic High School, was a junior mathematics major in the Spring Semester. She is also a recipient of the Hobart F. Heller, the Edson H. Taylor, the Eunice W. Dougherty and the Secondary Education and Foundations Telefund Scholarships.

Yegge is a member of the Mortar Board Society, Kappa Mu Epsilon honorary math fraternity, the Math Club, Tau Beta Sigma honorary band service sorority and the Physics Club. She also belongs to Phi Alpha Eta freshman women's honorary, the Honors Programs and the Society of Student Actuaries.
