She was honored at Eastern's recent spring commencement ceremony where President Stan Rives presented her with a Lord Medallion.

The Lord Scholarship is awarded annually at commencement to six junior or senior students, one from each undergraduate college within the University who have been nominated by a department chairperson.

Each recipient received a \$2,500 scholarship in addition to a gold medal and certificate.

Epley, a 1988 graduate of Pana High School, was a junior special education major in the Spring Semester. She is president of the Student Council for Exceptional Students, a member of Kappa Delta Pi and Sigma Rho Epsilon, and has been on the Dean's List. She recently received the Emma Reinhardt Award, established in 1962 by members of the Beta Psi Chapter of Kappa Delta Pi, in recognition of Mrs. Reinhardt, counselor to the chapter for 31 years.
