

ANKENBRAND NAMED ACTING DEAN

CHARLESTON, IL--Larry Ankenbrand of Charleston, associate dean of Eastern Illinois University's College of Health, Physical Education and Recreation since 1988, has been named acting dean of the College of HPER, effective Nov. 1.

He earned his bachelor's degree from Eastern in 1959, master's from Indiana State University in 1966, and doctorate from the University of Missouri in 1972.

Provost and Vice President for Academic Affairs Robert Kindrick said, "Dr. Ankenbrand's familiarity with the College of HPER and demonstrated competence will enable him to provide valuable service to the University during this transition."
