U.S.A. NEW YORK. SUFFOLK CO.: Froehlich Farm Preserve, Town of Huntington, Long Island, New York. Ca. 167 m south of West Rogues Path, just west of the old truck path. 40°50'21.17"N, 73°26'20.97"W; 54m elevation.

Tree ca. 7.6 m tall. 1 of 2 trees in immediate area. Growing at the edge of a old truck path across from a brushy 21 year old old-field with *Quercus prinus*, *Artemisia vulgaris*, *Prunus serotina*, *Ailanthus altissima*, *Rosa multiflora* and *Alliaria petiolata*.
