

'Good' comes to Eastern

CHARLESTON — Tickets for the Eastern Illinois University Theatre production of C.P. Taylor's *Good* are now on sale at the Fine Arts Ticket Office between 1 and 5 p.m. daily.

The relatively new play with music will open at 8 p.m. Friday in the Theatre of the Doudna Fine Arts Center and play consecutive performances through Dec. 6.

Directed by E.G. Gabbard, *Good*, is the story of how a "good" man gets caught up in the nightmare of the Third Reich and is told through the use of theatrical collage of realistic scenes, nightmare fantasy and musical counterpoint.

Written as a musical comedy, according to the playwright, *Good* is a tragic drama whose dark content is often comic.
