

Theater Productions Set At EIU During Semester

CHARLESTON — Three diverse major theatre productions are scheduled to be performed at Eastern Illinois University for spring semester.

E. G. Gabbard, Chairman of the Theatre Arts Department, said that each production will be different from the others in content and style.

The first is Moliere's satire on doctors, "The Imaginary Invalid." It is scheduled to be performed in the Fine Arts Theater on Feb. 14, 15, 21 and 22 at 8 p.m. and at 2 p.m. on the 23rd of Feb. Gerald Sullivan, Professor of Theatre Arts, will direct the production.

"Dracula Sabbat," a Reader's Theater production, will be in the Playroom of the Fine Arts Building on March 13, 14, 15 and 17 at 8 p.m. and a matinee will be held at 2 p.m.

on March 16. Donna Rice of the Theatre Arts Department is directing the choreographed drama that deals with witchcraft.

Harold Pinter's play "The Birthday Party" will be staged in the Fine Arts Theater at 8 p.m. April 18, 19, 25 and 26 with a matinee on April 27. Gabbard will direct the action.
