

Open auditions set for comedy

Eastern's theater arts department has scheduled open auditions for "The Doctor In Spite of Himself" at 7:30 p.m. Tuesday and Wednesday in the Doudna Fine Arts Center Playroom.

J. Sain, theater arts promotion and management director, said the 18th century play, a classic farce by the French playwright Moliere, has been adapted and will be directed by E.G. Gabbard of the theater department.

The story involves the wife of a worthless woodcutter who avenges a beating from her husband by passing

him off as a doctor. As a doctor, he sets out to cure a young woman who is lovesick, Sain said.

The play will open for two performances Nov. 19 and will return for three additional showings after Thanksgiving break, Sain added.

The play also will be Eastern's entry for the 1983 American College Theatre Festival competition in January, he said.
