Call For Papers:

Special Issue - Teaching History and Social Studies During and After COVID-19

The Councilor: A Journal of the Social Studies will be publishing one or more special issues that focus on teaching and learning history and social studies during and after COVID-19 lockdown.

We are open to a range of different types of submissions that include, but are not limited to:

- Theoretical discussions
- Histories
- Research studies
- Literature reviews
- Reflections
- Calls to Action

Questions that may be answered include:

- What does the pandemic reveal about history and social studies teaching during this time?
- What has been the experience of teaching history remotely and/or online during the pandemic?
- How have students, teachers, teacher candidates, administrators, and/or school boards approach the pandemic? What can we learn from these responses?
- What are histories/scholarship we should be made aware of to better understand the response of the pandemic on history and social studies teaching?

A completed manuscript is requested by 8/7/2020.

As a way to support the increase of responsibilities many scholars and teachers are facing at this time, accepted full papers will be due for peer review by a date negotiated with the editors approximately 10 weeks after acceptance.
